Diana Ruggiero is an assistant professor at the University of Memphis specializing in Spanish for specific purposes (SSP) and community service learning (CSL). Her research to date addresses issues in Language for specific purposes (LSP) and CSL curriculum development and assessment, including intercultural sensitivity development, heritage learners, medical Spanish interpreting, CSL project design, and the role and place of LSP and CSL in foreign language higher education. Ruggiero is published in the *Journal of Languages for Specific Purposes*, the *Revista de Lenguas para Fines Específicos*, the *ADFL Bulletin*, the *AAUSC Issues in Language Program Direction* (2017 volume), and *Hispania* in addition to other edited volumes on LSP and CSL. She also actively presents her research and gives workshops at regional, national, and international professional society conferences and symposia, including the MLA Annual Convention, the AATSP Annual Conference, The ISLSP/CIBER Business Language Conference, the ACTFL Annual Convention and World Language Expo, and the annual meeting of the European Association of Languages for Specific Purposes (AELFE). Ruggiero is currently developing coursework in SSP and CSL at the University of Memphis, including a study abroad course integrating CSL.
